ENTRY FORM

For all Smacks, Bawleys, MFOBs, Yachts & Dinghies

The Maldon Town Regatta has been running since before 1889 and you are cordially invited to this historic event.

The regatta consists of three races:

Estuary Race that will start off the Nass at Mersea Island and race up to Osea Island

Town race/Parade of Sail from Osea up to Maldon with a finish line off Maldon Yacht Club

Dinghy race for dinghies and Small dayboats starting and finishing off Maldon Yacht Club

After the Parade of Sail vessels can stay in Maldon or return to their moorings, as many berths as possible will be provided by the local yards as well as the visitors pontoon, contact with yards or your Class Captain would be best to ensure a berth is available.

Prize giving will be held at the rear of the Queens Head Public House.

Post prize giving beer and food will be available both in the Queens Head as well as the Maldon Little Ship Club with live entertainment at the Queens Head until the later hours.

Further details will be on the race instructions.

YACHTS/SMACKS/MFOBS

Smacks will race in three classes with a staggered start followed by the rest of the classes at timed intervals to avoid a congested start line
